



COVID-19 Update

24 March 2020

As you probably know by now, the NSW and Australian government require all **non-essential** gatherings to cease. The playing of Croquet fits the definition from Sport Australia as a non-essential gathering.

As a result:

- All CNSW events are cancelled from today 24/03/2020.
- Registration fees for all cancelled CNSW Events will be refunded by EFT. Please advise the Treasurer of account details to enable refunds to be made.
- Interclub competitions scheduled in the next six months should be cancelled and entry fees refunded.
- All Croquet Club activities should be cancelled. Maintain the lawns and gardens at a minimum level, ensuring that the hygiene protocols are followed.

CNSW understands that many clubs and their members may feel isolated as a result of government rules and asks clubs to keep in contact with members.
